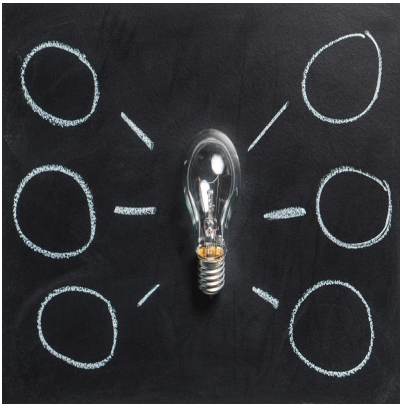




Switching To Energy Saving Bulbs
