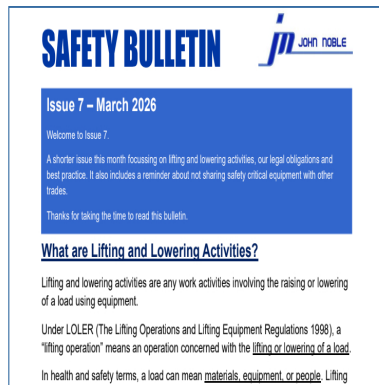




Safety Bulletin: issue 7
